### instructor's clinic

Friday, August 21  
9:00am-1:00pm

Instructors who sign up for this course will learn how to:

- Promote and develop opportunities within the USTA for wheelchair players, coaches and volunteers;
- Teach wheelchair tennis in the areas of mobility, stroke production, specialty shots and strategy;
- Increase awareness and integration of the benefits of wheelchair tennis for the player, community and their tennis club;
- Understand the types of wheelchair users and their chair set ups;
- Adjust drills and design drills for wheelchair students;
- Integrate chair athletes with able-bodied players,
- Create competitive programs and learn about the circuit; and
- Gain first hand knowledge of wheelchair tennis by feeding balls and actually competing in the sport!

### wheelchair camp

Friday, August 21 - Saturday, August 22

The camp is for players of all ages and ability levels - from brand new players to those who have been playing national and international tournaments.

Players will be broken out into groups depending on ability. Beginners will learn the basics (strokes and mobility) while the more advanced players will receive instruction and strategic tips that will help take them to the next level.

### One-up One-down Tournament

**a fun and exciting way for a chair player and able-bodied player to join forces and compete!**

Sunday, August 23

#### Tournament Draws

**“A” COMPETITIVE DRAW** - Suggested rating for chair players is Open, A and top B level players; rating for able-bodied players is: men 3.5 and under; women 4.5 and under.

**“B” RECREATION DRAW** - Suggested rating for chair players is B and C level; rating for able bodied players is: men 3.0 and under; women 3.5 and under. Exception: Quad players can team with a 4.0 male or a 4.5 female player.

Teams have the option to choose which of the above two draws they would like to play in. Draws may be combined if there are not enough participants in either draw. A team cannot play in both draws. All USTA rules apply. Chair players have the option to take two bounces if needed.

#### Format of Play

Doubles tournament. First round consolation or round robin. Tournament Director will determine which format to use, to insure that each team plays a minimum of two team matches.

## bios

### FRANK ADAMS

Frank is a PTR teaching professional and is currently the Head Teaching Pro at the Highlands Ranch Tennis Pavilion in Highlands Ranch, CO. Frank is also a Wheelchair Tennis Coach for the Colorado Wheelchair Tennis Foundation, as well as a trainer for both the USTA Recreational Coaches Workshop and Recreational QuickStart Tennis Training Workshop. In his spare time, Frank serves as the President for the USTA Intermountain Board of Directors and is currently on the USTA National Tennis in the Parks Committee. Frank has been named the USTA Magazine Grass Roots Hero, Colorado Wheelchair Tennis Foundation Pro of the Year, and won the Colorado Tennis Association's Arthur Ashe Award, Intermountain Tennis Association's Volunteer of the Year Award, Minority Coach's Workshop Arthur Ashe Award, and has been previously named PTR's Colorado Pro of the Year.

### RICH BERMAN

Rich is a PTR teaching Professional and is currently the head instructor at Rich's Tennis School in Erie, CO. Rich is one of the nations top wheelchair tennis instructors, and has been teaching wheelchair tennis for 15 years. He also co-authored with Bill Trubey, the PTR Wheelchair Tennis Instructors Manual and Video. Rich was the personal coach for Australia's former world #1 wheelchair tennis star, David Hall (12 years). David was a six-time ITF Wheelchair Tennis World Champion, Silver and Bronze medal winner at the Atlanta Paralympics in 1996, gold and silver medal winner at the 2000 Sydney Paralympics, and Silver and Bronze medalist at the 2004 Paralympics in Athens. Rich was honored in 1999 for his work with wheelchair tennis by receiving the PTR Volunteer of the Year Award.

### DAN JAMES

Dan is a PTR and USPTA teaching Professional residing in Oakdale, MN. He became a member of the USTA's National Wheelchair coaching staff in 1998 as the assistant coach of the World Team Cup, and was the men's head coach from 1999-2005. In 2003, he joined the USTA full time as the National Manager for Wheelchair Tennis, running the training program for all teams as well as supervising the grassroots initiatives. He was the US men's head coach at the 2000 Paralympics in Sydney, Australia, the 2004 games in Athens, as well as the 2008 games in Beijing. Dan is a member of the IWTA Wheelchair Coach's Commission and a member of the ITF Wheelchair Tennis Committee. Dan was named PTR's 2002 Minnesota Pro of the Year, Racquet Sports Industry Magazine's 2003 Wheelchair Tennis Champion, USPTA's 2004 Northern Division Professional of the Year, and International Wheelchair Tennis Association's 2007 International Wheelchair Tennis Coach of the Year.
