

# **Colorado Congressional Delegation VA Hospital Veterans Forum**

On Friday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, Senator Ken Salazar, Representative Ed Perlmutter and Representative Tom Tancredo will be holding a Veterans Forum in cooperation with the Veterans Administration to listen to concerns about the new Veterans Administration Hospital and Health Care Clinic to be constructed at the Fitzsimons/Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora.

Six veterans organizations have been asked to submit testimony to the congressional delegation and the VA about their concerns for the new VA plan. PVA Mountain States Chapter President, James Sack, will be one of the six representatives from veterans organizations testifying.

Mr. Joe Williams, Assistant Deputy Secretary for Health Operations and Management and Glen Grippen, Director of VISN-19, will present an overview of the most recent VA plans for the project.

Veterans will have an opportunity to ask questions after the VA presentation and the veterans groups present their testimony.
